SUNDAY PARKING

Limited parking spaces are available in the St. Mark's College parking lot.

Pay Parking Options: North Parkade, UBC Rose Garden Parkade. Street parking is available at designated points on Campus. Please pay attention to parking meters.

UBC Parking Services allowed us to use some parking lots close to St. Mark's. These parking spaces are for parishioners attending the 930am and 1130am Mass services. **Scan the QR code with your phone to access the rate option**.

6000 Iona Drive - Lot Zone 5602 in the Honkmobile App - This lot is across Theology Mall. There are about 18 parking spots.

Walter Gage Road - Lot Zone 5644 in the Honkmobile App - There are also 18 parking spaces on one row.

A rate label "St Mark" has been made available on the Honkmobile Parking App at these two locations, 6000 Iona Drive and Walter Gage Road respectively. This "St Mark" rate is visible from 8:30am to 12pm on SUNDAYS ONLY. This rate will allow anyone who selects the rate to park for 2.5 hours and pay only \$2.00.
